## **Reed People - Vision**

Promotion of a greater understanding of the Christian Faith to new believers and existing adherents of the Christian Faith, through teaching on, and the study of, the Word of God 'The Holy Bible'. The objective is to help individuals to be more effective in their personal faith and have a better understanding of who they are as a believer in Christ Jesus; to develop as a **Restored, Encouraged, Equipped Disciple, Pentecost Empowered, Offering Perfect Love Everywhere**, as prescribed by the Word of God 'The Holy Bible'; thus helping the individual to be an asset to the wider communities to which they are associated.

To support Christians worldwide, Practically, Physically and Spiritually by providing, either directly or in partnership with other Christian Organisations, Relief, Shelter, Refuge, Comfort and Restoration. Education, Vocational, Agriculture, Business and Financial Management Training.

- (a) Practical: Where possible providing practical assistance to an individual or groups, by provision of finance and or professionals, specialists and volunteers to help alleviate a practical need.
- (b) Physical: Where possible providing physical assistance to an individual or groups, by provision of finance and or professionals, specialists and volunteers to help alleviate a physical need.
- (c) Spiritual: The expectation is where the practical and physical needs are being met, and then the spiritual need can also be addressed.
- (d) The outworking of the Practical, Physical and Spiritual will be by provision of Relief, Shelter, Refuge, Comfort and Restoration, Education, Vocational Training, Agriculture and Business and Financial Management.

**Relief: Anything that lessens, pain, discomfort, fear, anxiety, or the like; Assistance, in the form of money or food.**

Benefits to non Christians: It is possible that projects intended to meet the practical and physical need of Christians in a locality, may also be a benefit to the wider community. This would not be a reason not to provide the assistance required: on the contrary, it should be viewed as an opportunity to demonstrate the Christian ethos of "Love your neighbour."
